You can, of course, trailer a short way as well.</p>

<p>Horse Camping Rules</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Quiet at 10:00pm ● Propane Fire Pit OK ● Masks required when within 6' of each other! ● If the ground is damp/wet, don't drive in the soft grounds along the fence line to get to the horse corrals, drive-in the left side closer to the arena to get to the corral area. 	<p>Access to the Showgrounds</p> <p>The gate is locked, so ensure you coordinate with your host for access to the grounds.</p>	<p>Facility Provided</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 12 pipe corrals ● Non-Potable Water for the horses ● Bring your own drinking water ● Bring Wheelbarrows and racks. Spread the manure in the open area in the Northwest corner of the facilities (behind the arena). (Coordinate with Host) ● Bring about 4 long hoses to run water from the clubhouse to the corrals (Coordinate with Host) ● Bathrooms (Toilets) available - no showers
